





CLEAR LAKE UPDATE

Fly fishing at Clear Lake? Who would have thunk it? But it did happen. On Sunday, January 8th, the airplane in the above picture landed on the ice at Clear Lake. The pilot then proceeded to pull his auger and fishing gear from behind the seat and headed across the lake,



looking for a likely spot to fish. It is unknown if he had any luck, but he did stay about an hour and a half. Other anglers have had some success. Quite a few people have been catching some nice crappies. There have been some close to a pound. There have also been some reports of walleye being caught.



This I can believe, but the size of the fish has been disputed. There was a rumor floating around about a 4 pounder coming out of the lake. THE FISHING HOLE

A fishing hole is as much a state of mind as it is a place. If an artist were to paint the "old fishing hole," his canvas might show a deep place in a woodland, a large mouth bass creek overhung with moss-draped oaks. Or it might suggest a shadowy channel where sea trout cruise in a saltwater estuary. There are other possibilities: a special cove along the rocky shoreline of a small mouth bass reservoir; a sparkling riffle below a bridge on a Western trout stream backdropped by mountain peaks; a suburban bluegill pond lined with cattails, where bright red bobbers deck under the surface to the shouts of small boys. Above all, in the painting as in life, the fishing hole would be a spot where reality enhances dreams instead of stifling them.-*Bob Saile*

My guess is that the fishing hole started life as a swimming hole, a deep wide part of a stream, warmed by the sun, where you could tie a length of rope from a nearby tree and swing out and drop into the water. I think the term "fishing hole" was meant to convey a similar sort of place, shaded and cool, but too small for tree swings. Such places were once called "pools", but now that word now that word has come to mean a costly manmade structure with clear sterile water and a ladder to get in and out. These luxury items are mostly found in people's yards, but "fishin' holes" (as they are properly named) exist wherever there are bodies of water with fish in them. Like the Atlantic Ocean.
