

It's been a dry year which has proven once again yield numbers of flathead catfish in the Minnesota River. This is brought on by the fact that the big fish stay concentrated in the deeper pools of the river making them vulnerable to knowledgeable anglers. With that in mind, I had a chat with Huon Newberg, Area Fisheries Supervisor, and he has told me that there has been an extensive "tagging" of flatheads done by DNR staff and that the fish are really mobile. It is not unheard of for these fish to travel 50 th 100 miles. There has been a recent increase in interest to fish these large and very old creatures. Along with the traditional flathead catfishermen, we now see many anglers diversifying to catfish. This of course is great, but it may be the time to start to look at regulation of the noble species so we do not jeopardize the ever present trophy population. What do you think? Let's talk about at at the next meeting, see ya' there.



September Meeting


