### FROM THE PRESIDENT. . .

Let me take this opportunity to wish you all happy holidays, and to remind you of the change in the meeting date for the next meeting from our regular last Thursday of the month.

As some of you read in our last newsletter, the Mankato wastewater treatment plant is of great concern to all Minnesota River interests for a number of reasons, not the least of which is the message that will be sent ato agricultural producers if all concerns regarding phosphorus are not addressed. The good news is, I think we're headed in that direction.

In other things to pass along regarding the river, the Minnesota River Basin Joint Powers Board, with the help of 2nd District Congressman David Minge, have sent in our application to become one of President Clinton's 10 American Heritage Rivers. With this designation we will look to form new partnerships at the national level to help not only efforts to clean up the river, but those of attention, celebration, multiple use, and coordination of those national interestes to better our entire watershed in a number of ways.

Fishing at Clear Lake this Winter (if we get some decent ice) may be better than first anticipated. First of all the bullhead population will not be a factor and there are remaining walleye, northern, and panfish after last year's freeze out. With this in mind we have voted to hold this year's fishing contest on the lake. It should be a great day and it looks as if we will have many prizes. At our last meeting, Orville Rannow donated a rifle and scope to the contest, we thank him for his generosity. I have had some conversations with NUASF member Al Zwack and he is workiing to obtain prizes from several manufacturers as well. Jim Hulke was selected/railroaded into being chair of the prize committee, please contact him as to prizes collected from various places. The compilation of that list of supporters is important for post thank yous, so make sure Jim is aware of who gave.


