## **Clear Lake Update**

Plans for the restoration and restocking of Clear Lake are moving slowly but surely forward. Because of the size of this project it is taking a little longer to get everything in place. Instead of just treating the lake, there will be several bodies of water treated. A fish trap will also be installed at the outlet of the lake. Work may have already started to prevent rough fish from entering the system from School Lake. The way things stand right now, Clear Lake won't be treated until next spring, with restocking to take place shortly thereafter.

We have set a goal of raising \$10,000 to help with the restoration. We have already received a pledge of \$1,000 from the Sleepy Eye Sportsmens Club and \$1,000 from the New Ulm Area Sports Fishermen. We hope to have the full amount raised by April 1st, 1999. In the coming months our campaign will get into full swing. Having Clear Lake returned to a viable sport fishery will greatly benefit the community, so be sure and tell your friend sand neighbors to support our cause.


