# Clear Lake restoration moving along

The Clear Lake restoration project is moving along quite well. All affected landowners have been contacted, and they have all agreed to let the project go forward. If everything falls into place, the lake will be treated this fall.

We are in the process of starting a fund drive to help the DNR pay for the treatment of the lake. Thus far Sleepy Eye Sportsmans Club has pledged \$1,000.00, and at the last meeting our Club had pledged \$1,000.00. We have set a goal of \$10,000.00 to be raised by December 1, 1998. We hope to get other area service groups and individuals to help us reach this goal.

The lake looks pretty tough right now. The last Seechi disc readings were only 2 ft. The water is very brown with lots of suspended algae. The only fish that anyone has reported catching are builheads.

#### Board of Directors to add two members

At a previous meeting it was decided, because of the growth of the club, to expand the NUASF Board of Directors by two members. We have been looking for prospective candidates for several months and no one has come forward. At the July meeting we will be electing two more board members, therefore we will be needing at least two people to be nominated for these positions. 
