



The possible explanation was tulibee spawning and keep ing the water there moving or that because of the warm late fall and earlyuWinter it had just created unpredictable conditions. Glen and I experienced similar conditions on Cut Foot. On the west end of the lake it was all of 18 to 20 inches deep, but when we went to a spot where we had gone year after year to catch MANY fish, we ran into only about 10 to 12 inches. Even with all of the cold weather, the water may for what ever reason had been a few degrees warmer there or closer to current or what ever. All I know is it's a reality check when you see it first hand. So be damn careful this year no matter where you are going. The club doesn't want to go to any funerals, it takes away time from fishin'.


ing seven new members each. The 1999 memberhsip drive is already underway with two new members signed. The winner of the yearly membership drive receives a club jacket for his efforts.
