#### CLEAR LAKE UPDATE

## Aeration system started on the lake

The aeration system was started on Saturday, December 9th. It was not started for lack of oxygen; we started the system to get a head start because conditions are ripe for a rapid oxygen decline. The lake froze cloudy because of snowfall as the lake was freezing. Add to that the amount of snow cover already on the lake and it spells trouble for stable oxygen levels. What we needed was clear ice and no snow cover to allow sunlight to penetrate and keep underwater plants alive and producing oxygen. We are hoping that by starting the system early we get a head start and keep the oxygen up throughout the winter.

At our October meeting we had some discussion about trying to get rock tile inlets installed in the Clear Lake watershed. Since then we already have two landowners tell us they are interested in having the inlets on their property. There is a very good

chance that we could have several more in line before spring. If anyone know any of the landowners around the lake, talk to them about having some of these inlets installed. With what the county pays and the \$75.00 our club will donate for each inlet, there is no coast to the landowner. Under this



program each landowner can only do three inlets. If you would like more information contact Scott Sparlin.



I have started to research some possibilities on funds to supplement our rock inlet iniative. So far I have three different possibilities and I am waiting to hear what my next steps will be on behalf of the club.

In closing this month I would like to extend my most sincere wishes to everyone for a great holiday season. See ya" at the meeting.






