CLEAR LAKE UPDATE

At approximately 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 10th, Clear Lake came full circle. It was again stocked with game fish. A truck carrying fished trapped that morning from Clear Lake by Waseca, arrived at the landing and proceeded to deposit it's load into our Clear Lake. it was a momentous occasion, watching the newly arrived bass, sunfish and crappies being carried out into the lake. There were approximately twenty pair of each species stocked at this time. We were told by DNR personnel that there were no rough fish found in the traps that were placed in Clear Lake after it was treated. This is the best possible situation, as we will be starting with a clean pond. This should really jump start the fish that have been stocked. All fishing will also be closed for one year. There is a chance that some of the panfish could spawn three times before fishing is allowed. It



has been a long time coming.

There was a lot of work with our food stand to raise money to help pay for the restoration. And the negotiations seemed to go on forever. But we did it, finally.

Thanks to everyone for the extra

effort and a special thanks to the Minnesota DNR for seeing this protect through to the end.

Kids Fishing Contest


