CLEAR LAKE UPDATE

Looks to be in good shape



The lake looks to be in good shape, a little green, but not too bad. A spawning survey is scheduled to be done and we will have a report from Hugh Valient at our next meeting. At the last meeting we had some discussion on cer-

tain problems there may be in the Clear Lake watershed. We talked about the possibility of getting rock tile intakes installed around the lake. There will more discussion on this at the next meeting. On Saturday September 9th, a

group of us met at the lake to do some repairs on the aeration system. One of the air lines was either hit by a boat and pulled, or came apart on it's own. We got lucky and found the end of the line that stayed submerged, and reconnected it. We also found several leaks close to shore where the lines always seem to stick out of the water. We are recognized on a state wide level as an organization on the front lines of promoting and advocating for our mission. Any of you who do not have a copy of our mission can obtain one at the meeting, it is right in our organizational pamphlet.

So bring a friend, the grounds are beautiful this time of year and I'm sure you will enjoy yourself and as an added attraction, for those members who bring a guest, the club will buy you each a refreshment of your choice. See you there.
