Salvaged fishing pier

As many of you may remember, last spring we salvaged the old fishing pier at Clear Lake. We have sold most of the frame and planks but we have most of the foam from the floats. This is not bead board, it is the good styrofoam. The or 47 inches by 64 inches. There is approximately 2800 square feet in all. We are asking 50 cents for a full sheet and 25 cents for the half sheet. There also are some assorted pieces of plastic sheeting that enclosed the styrofoam. 
Dixon Lake Trip Fill Up


