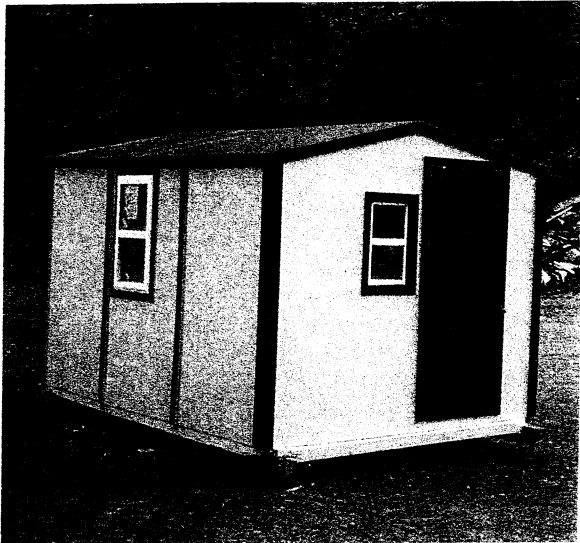

Brown fish house repaired

We had a work night on August 23rd to repair the brown fish house. It was in very

bad shape. The siding and roof were about ready to fall off. Mice had gotten in the walls and were chewing the insulation to pieces. Two of the runners had to be replaced as the ends were broken off this past winter. We also discovered one place where the house almost started on fire. When the siding was removed, we found the stud



charred and the insulation melted half way up the wall. It looks like it may have started from a candle placed under the house. This is something that will have to be watched very closely. We don't want to be burning our fish house down. We have replaced the siding and the roof. The door was moved in anticipation of putting

wheels on the house.

We added a window and gave the house a fresh coat of paint. This house is ready to go. We do however need to give the big house some attention.

This one has not been on the ice in three years. It needs a good cleaning and some paint. We will be doing this on Saturday, September 22nd starting

Joe Fellegy inducted into Minnesota Fishing Hall of Fame

Joe Fellegy, formerly of New Ulm, was inducted into the Minnesota Fishing Hall of Fame, for his role in Minnesota Sport Fishing, on August 18th of this year. Fellegy gained renown as a guide on Mille Lacs Lake and later as a respected journalist and author. He joined Al Lindner, Ron Schara, John Peterson, Gary Roach and sixteen other distinguished individuals who were inducted with the Charter Class of 2000.

In order to be considered for admission to the Hall of Fame candidates must meet several criteria:

- An individual must be a state resident and be at least fifty years of age.
- The person must be nominated and elected by the current members of the Hall of Fame.
- Candidates must have made a significant contribution to sport fishing as a guide, promoter, tournament angler, manufacturer, educator, or legislator.

The ceremony was held in Walker, Minnesota on the Minnesota Fishing Hall of Fame campus.

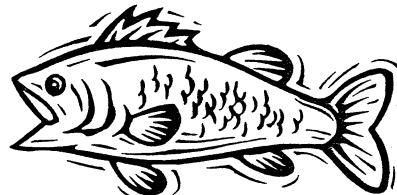
