CLEAR LAKE UPDATE

WE HAVE ICE!

We have ice! For a while this winter it did not seem like we would ever get any. The aeration system was started on Sunday, December 30th. The oxygen is still quite high, 16.4 on the 29th, but we were given the okay to start the system. I would like to thank the guys who helped get the thin ice signs in place that day. We had eight inches of ice that day.

The fish are also cooperating to a certain extent. Crappies and bass have been biting with some regularity though they have been mostly on the small side. There have been some reports of crappies that were about 1/2 pound. Minnows are the bait they are after. Hopefully the ice will continue to build so we can start driving onto the lake.

By the time you read this, we hope to have all the houses on the lakes. The two houses with propane heat will be going to Sleepy Eye Lake. The other two will be going to Clear Lake and they both have wood heat. When you use these houses please bring wood along. Also as you head out to the lake, please be careful; we don't want any of you going through the ice. When you use

any of the club's houses, please take any garbage along home with you.

On Saturday, January 6th, we did get the houses on both lakes. Thanks to all the guys who helped. Special thanks go out to Randy and Cory Tiell of American Lawn & Landscape, who hauled the brown house out to Clear Lake.


