We did pick out one that we will be asking him to look into, that being a fishing pier for Riverside Park.

A recommendation from the membership to move forward on an awareness heightening campaign for city runoff was endorsed at the November meeting. As a part of that action we will be taking on a spring project called Community Clean Up for water quality. We will be doing this with the help of the 3M RRAT's and I will be scheduling meetings for after the first of the year to get it rolling with them. The idea is to create a video that could be used in public access programming and in other venues was also endorsed at the last meeting. I have had contact with KARE 11 and Joe Howeritz who is the production manager for "Minesota Bound". He has agreed to put together a professional video with our direction for about \$3,000 to \$4,000 dollars. It was brought up at the last meeting that we should seek partnership to do this with 3 or 4 other groups. That is being done now. If you have any contact with another organization that may want to contribute to this, please contact me and we can get the ball rolling and be ready come spring when we take to the streets of New Ulm.

There is so much that goes on at a meeting that is important, that we simply can't get into this newsletter; that it behooves you to come and see what all the hubbub is about.

Did you know we have a website up and running? Did you know we have a new fish house to go with the other 4 we have? For all the details and more, come on out.

I'll close with a Christmas wish. May we all do the best we can with what we have and never lose sight of what can be. See ya' at the next meeting.

The Stoney Award


At the February meeting we will award this year's Stoney Award to one of our members We will start taking nominations at the December meeting.




