## **CLEAR LAKE UPDATE**

At our last meeting Hugh Valient, from DNR Fisheries, gave us an update on the fish population at Clear Lake. As most of us know, there doesn't seem to be a lot of sunfish in the lake. The walleye seem to be doing all right though there were not a lot of them caught this winter. The bass are everywhere. Some days it was not possible to fish with two lines. The crappies, though, are the real success story. Last fall the test nets yielded an average of more that 150 fish per trap. As most anyone who fished the lake this winter can attest, at times the crappie bite was awesome. We have been very lucky this winter as we have not had to start the aeration system yet. With a little

more luck we may make it through the rest of the season. We did get some bad news though. There seems to be a carp population in the lake again. How big the problem is we are not sure, and what can be done about it, we don't know. For now the lake looks to be in very good shape. One thing that would help would be a little more moisture to bring the lake level up for spawning this spring.


