It will also boast an eagle nesting viewing site. This marks the fifth year of the nest and they are there right now.

This next meeting will be our last before the Walleye Northern opener. So I have asked Al Zwach to give a presentation on the latest tackle innovations and to offer tips on how to increase our chances for a bite. I look forward to seeing you all there.
