I was asked at the last meeting to include procedure and etiquette for using the houses. 1. If you do not have a key you can get one for one dollar by coming to a meeting or by contacting our new secretary Ross Nelson. 2. If you plan on using the big house on Clear Lake always take wood with you including kindling. Leave the wood pile well stocked with both wood and kindling when you depart. 3. Keep houses clean, orderly and always take out what you bring with you including garbage. 4. All houses have a hookup for propane except the big house and you will need a tank if you want any heat. 5. If you want to reserve a house for private usage you can do so by contacting Ross Nelson or Scott Sparlin. It will be on a first come first serve basis.

If you have not had a chance to sign up for the club's winter trip to Wabay you can do so at the next meeting and get all the details from trip coordinator Al Zwach.

Just a note on the February meeting which is our biggest of the year, we will be having Lee Sundmark, Area Fisheries Manager from Hutchinson give a presentation at our meeting to provide updates and fish management strategies for the future of Clear Lake, Lake Hanska and Sleepy Eye Lake.
