Lake Diefenbaker Revisited

On July 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, club member, Jerry Carlson, my brother, Ron Holm of Dubuque, Iowa, and I went fishing with Eric Olson and Mike Knutson at their camp on Lake Diefenbaker, Saskatchewan, Canada. It was too hot; highs in the upper 80's and low 90's, The sky was too bright, with bright sunny days everyday. The water was too murky, with significant run-off from the Rocky Mountains. The lake too calm; imagine a 140-mile long mirror. How was the fishing? Fantastic! We had limits of 1 1/2 lb. to 5 lb. walleyes every day. On the first day Jerry landed a 32 in.-12 lb. walleye and on the second day I landed a 31 in.-11 lb. walleye. We landed lots of 10 to 12 in. perch so we each took home a bag of 20 perch each. I also brought home an 8 lb. northern that they took the y-bones out of.

MrO's and Mr. K's fish camp is a real, world-class, walleye fishing secret. This huge reservoir of the South Saskatchewan River, while having a hydro-electric dam, is managed first and foremost for walleye production. This means the water level is never lowered during walleye spawn and hatch, even if there are electric needs. Therefore, it has every year-class of walleye available. We caught fish from 6 inches to 32 inches and virtually every size in between.

The camp is a world-class operation with everything included. Guide, food, boats, and even tackle, are included. I

learned the first year they have at least as good, and in most cases better, equipment than I have. This year I brought only a suit case. And the food! Every day great meals are made to perfection. They serve walleyes so many different ways that you want to taste them all, but sometimes you just don't have the room. Every fish morsel I tried was cooked perfectly. I consider myself a pretty good cook

but no way could I top these guys. I think the cooking is like the fishing they do. Mike Knutsen made the comment, "We're probably better fishermen than most because of T.O.W. (time on water)". The same can be said for their food preparation. They cook so well because they cook every day and have really learned how to do it.

I know this article sounds like a commercial, but fellow club members, you are missing out on an opportunity to fish the finest walleye water in North America. Don't believe me? In 1997 Minnesota guru, Al Lindner wrote, "Lake Diefenbaker is undoubtedly the best Lake in North America, for pro or novice, to catch a legitimate 10 lb. walleye". He wrote this after a 2-day tournament where 13 walleyes ever 10 lbs. were registered.

Eric has generously given the club a discounted deal. The deal is almost 50% of the normal charge. Book soon; I can't believe he can give this discount forever. I have gone every year since the first year I went, and plan to continue annually as long as I can.
