The photos are fish caught and released by Al Zwach, New Ulm, MN. He was fishing the Minnesota River. The larger walleye was caught on Saturday, November 25th, and measured 30", the Sunday lunker went 28". Al caught a 31", round bellied whopper on Saturday that did not get photographed.

All fish were caught on a Northland Fireball jig and minnow. Last year during the same time frame Al caught and released a 32" Minnesota River walleye that weighed just over 16 pounds.
