

Reports of both flathead and channel catfish are coming in with great sizes and numbers of fish. At Riverside Park this week anglers are fishing the sand bar in front of the landing and really catching walleye in good numbers there as well, not to mention all the other species of fish that are being caught like believe it or not crappies and white bass. Things are happening on the Minnesota and Cottonwood Rivers; I would give it try if you have never gone there before. It's not difficult fishing, simply get some night crawlers or if you have the time dig some worms (which by the way I feel are even better than crawlers in a lot of instances) and throw out a plain long shanked no. 4 hook or a separated spinner with a 6 to 10 inch snell and watch the fun begin. I feel like I'm back writing the Fisherman's Corner, I better quit with the tips.

I was just looking over a book that was given to the club by author Rob Buffler who is an expert on alternative species fishes such as largemouth buffalo, sheepshead, suckers and a whole host of others.
