Reese receives State older workers award

NUASF member, Joyce Reese, Lafayette, was among twelve older workers from the State of Minnesota who received the 2010 Minnesota Valley Action Council's (MVAC) Outstanding Older Worker award.

Each year a week is set aside to celebrate "Minnesota's Older Workers and Outstanding Employers of Older Workers". The 2010 celebration luncheon and awards ceremony was held at the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum in Chanhassen on Thursday, October 14. Each Outstanding Older Worker and several Outstanding Employers of Older Workers nominated were presented with a framed certificate from the State of Minnesota signed by Governor Tim Pawlenty.

Reese, through the MVAC Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP), works at the Lafayette Charter School. Her title is office assistant. Her job consists of office tasks, marketing the school, preparing student projects for teach-

ers, on occasion teaching students in art class and tending to students who need a band aid or have their temperature taken.

Summers Reese spends as CCMR Administrative Assistant, under the direction of Scott Sparlin, at the Regional River History and Information Center in Riverside Park on the Minnesota River. The River History Center is located in the historic Franklin school building offering artifacts and information about the regional rivers for visitors. Reese completes all types of office work and creative art projects, researches new ideas for the River Center, sets up displays, educates visitors on the History of the Minnesota


