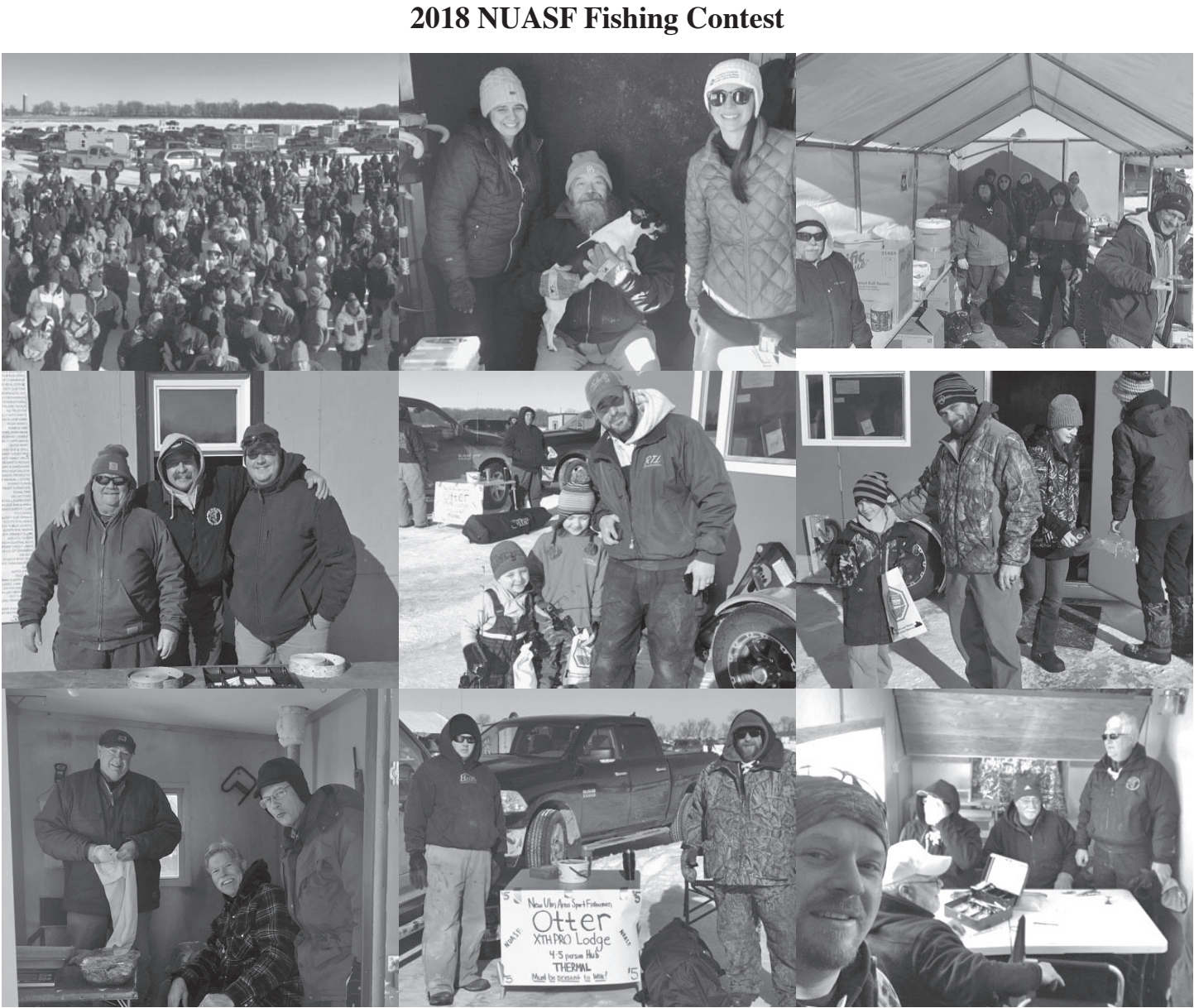

**F. DNR Fisheries Report will be next month.**

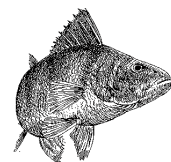

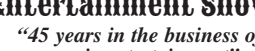
